Why a FARR Centre?

- A FARR Centre, Facilitated Academic Resource and Research Centre, allows Trinity Western University to deliver its quality programs (Leadership & Business) partnering with colleges and universities globally who desire to cultivate new opportunities for their students both in country and internationally.
- Taking one semester, one year or two years in their local college saves money for the students and their families.
- The student will complete their required program in country at the FARR Centre (the length of time depends on the program) and then head to Canada to complete their degree.

Leadership Foundation PG Certificate Course at the Stella Maris College

- The partnership program with Stella Maris (Autonomous) is called the **Gateway Express Pathway in Leadership**.
- One semester is completed at the FARR Centre at Stella Maris (Autonomous)
 - 5 Pre-Masters Course
 - LDRS 300, 302, 303, 310, 410
 - Upon successful completion of these 5 courses with a minimum B average (3.0 GPA) the student will then be eligible to take LDRS 500 their first masters course in country.
 - 1 Masters Course
 - LDRS 500 Leadership Foundations

TWU FARR Centre at Stella Maris (Autonomous)

The following semesters will take place at Trinity Western University in Canada (17-18 months).

Successful completion of the Pre-Masters (5 courses) and Masters (13 courses) will take a total program completion time of 21-22 months (4 months in country and 17-18 months abroad).

The degree of a Master of Arts (M.A.) in Leadership will be conferred upon successful completion of this program.

TWU programs delivered online around the world with trained Academic Facilitators who create Learning Labs on location with the educational partners to maximize learner success and ensure quality of program delivery.





ONLINE: Students will engage in the online course, reading through the units, watching videos, participating in interactive learning activities (e.g. simulation, quizzes, interviews), and preparing for assessments.

FACE-TO-FACE: Students will also attend learning labs on campus to engage with their peers and facilitators in an active learning approach. A TWU Facilitator will guide them through learning activities, helping them understand the course and prepare for assessments. Activities include discussions, group projects, debates, presentations, case studies, experiments, labs, and many more!





The Role of the Facilitator in the FARR Center Learning Model Facilitator will guide students through TWU courses by:

- following the facilitation guide established by the faculty subject matter expert;
- establishing a positive, goal oriented learning environment to ensure the attainment of learning outcomes;
- developing a thorough understanding of each course and how to facilitate it effectively;
- planning daily active learning activities as outlined in course materials and facilitation guides;
- facilitating the exchange of assignments and feedback between students and faculty; and
- maintaining accurate records of student attendance, assessments, and achievement.

The Role of the Facilitator in the FARR Center Learning Model In addition to facilitating courses, they will support students in their learning by:

- coaching students in study strategies to effectively learn the course material;
- guiding students to develop critical thinking skills;
- supporting students as they learn the skills of academic writing for a North American context; and
- providing formative feedback on student work.



These learning activities (both online and F2F) will help students develop key 21st century skills, such as critical thinking, reflective learning, creativity, and collaboration.

Step 5: Housing

In anticipation of coming to Canada you will need to consider where you will live for the 17-18 months and beyond should you choose the apply for a 2 year work Visa and stay and work in Canada.

We recommend living on TWU Langley campus at least for the first few months until you are comfortable with the community and transportation.

TWU Housing is the place for you to get information and get connected with housing staff to help you secure a safe, affordable place to begin your life in Canada.

Each student is responsible to secure their own housing prior to coming to Canada.

Next Steps: Step 6: Student VISA Midway through the GEP Program your Academic Facilitator will initiate the student VISA application process.

Each student will require a student VISA to enter Canada and study. TWU Admissions staff in Canada will generate a specific letter needed for you to apply for your student VISA . Once generated and distributed, you will follow the outlined steps to apply for your VISA.

Give yourself a minimum of 8 weeks to apply and receive approval.

Step 7: Working in Canada & Student Work VISA Once in Canada, International students are permitted to work up to 20 hours/ week on their student VISA. Please note that TWU cannot guarantee employment.

Near the end of your MA Leadership Program, you will be provided information about obtaining a two year work VISA after completion of your studies should you wish. Please note TWU does NOT issue VISAS nor will we guarantee employment or job placement.
