The digital training of the first batch of 20 Village Health nurses was launched on **18th August 2017** as the Directorate of Public Health wanted to train about 275 nurses through PMGDISHA.

Crop Insurance I was distributed to 91 farmers by the District Collector Ms. S. Sundaravalli, I.A.S on **19th November 2017** at SMCEPC and continued till 30th November 2017. Nearly ten lakh farmers obtained crop insurance during this period in Tamil Nadu through CSC's.
