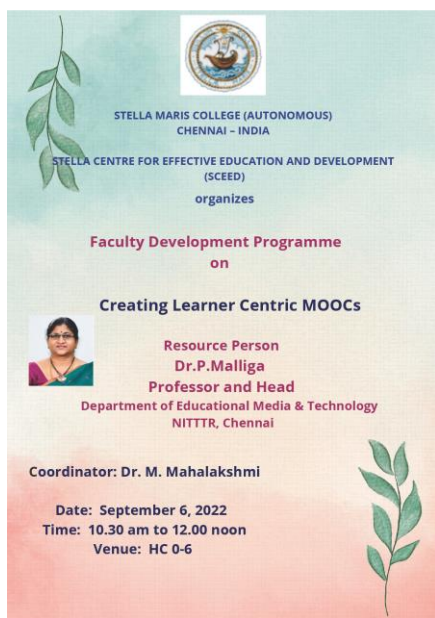


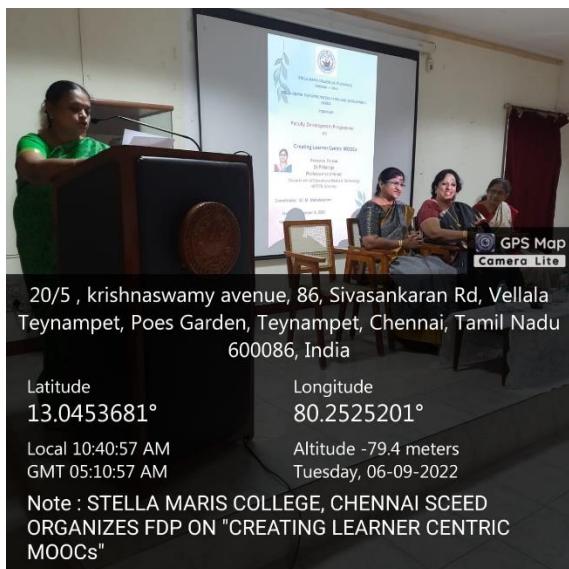
SCEED ACTIVITIES 2022-23

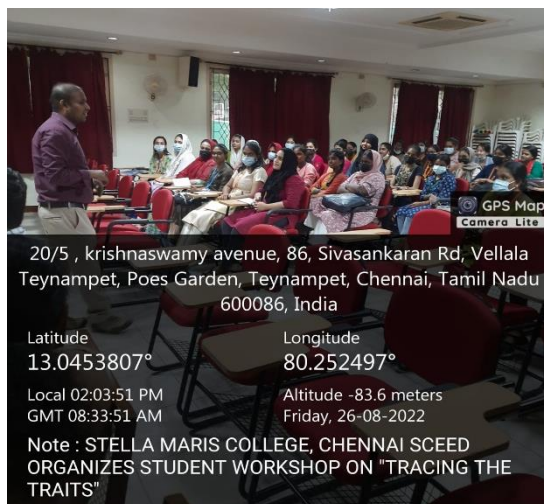




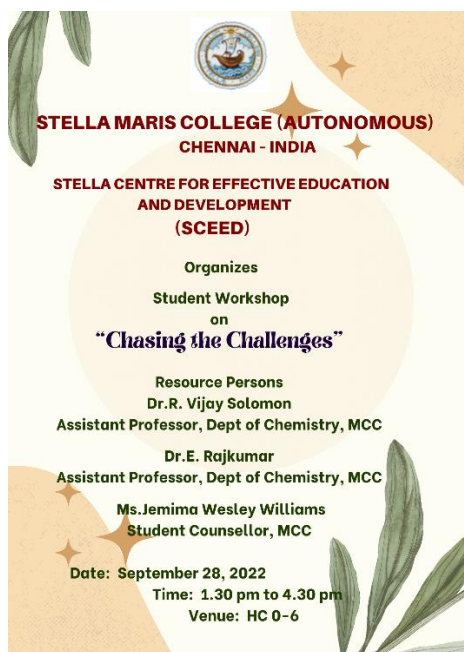
Student Training Workshops were conducted with a focus on Identifying their strengths, Overcoming challenges, Report writing for Project Work and Eco consciousness.

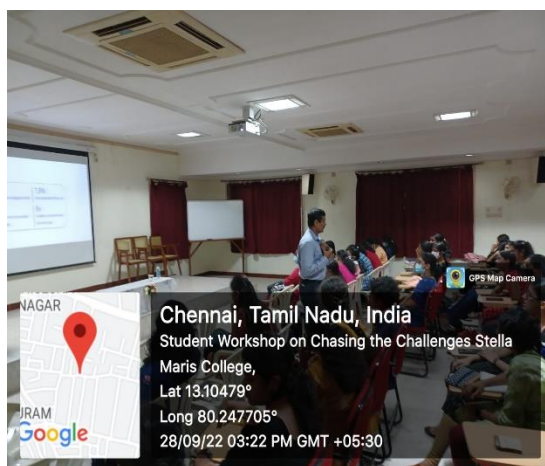
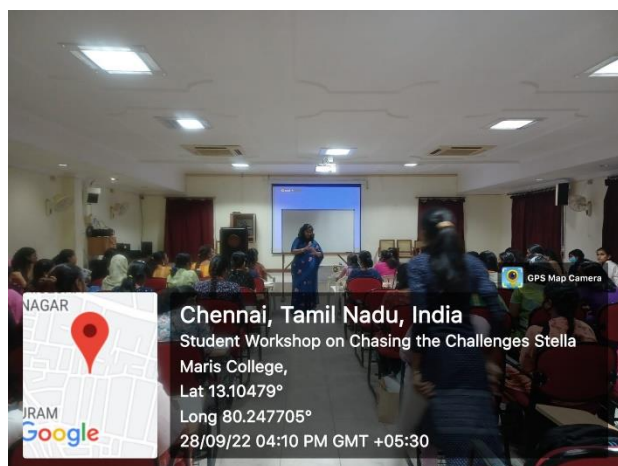

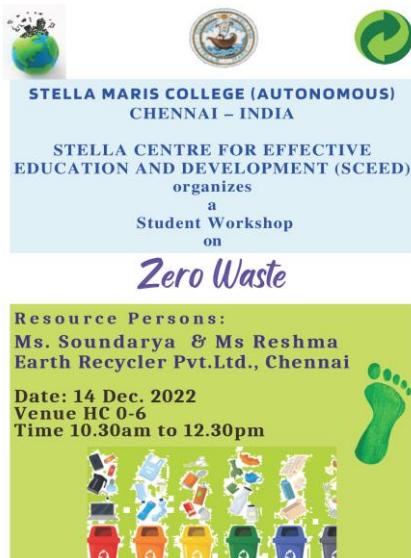
SCEED facilitated the conduct of **Energy, Environment and Green Audit** in September 2022 by the Accredited Energy Audit Firm M/s. NIN Energy India Private Limited. The assessment of Environmental impact of the institution, energy consumption scenario, carbon foot print, waste disposal, water audit and green cover of the campus were done. Water and Energy conservation facilities in the campus were studied and the Audit report was submitted and suggestions for sustainable practices were given.



A **Workshop** for the UG students on “**Zero Waste**” was conducted on **December 14, 2022**.

Experts from **Earth Recycler Private Limited** showcased the various measures in Waste management that can be imbibed by the students. **Ms.Soundarya and Ms.Reshma** explained the

different processes involved in large scale waste recycling. They interacted with the students on the effective waste segregation and motivated them to spread the message in their localities.

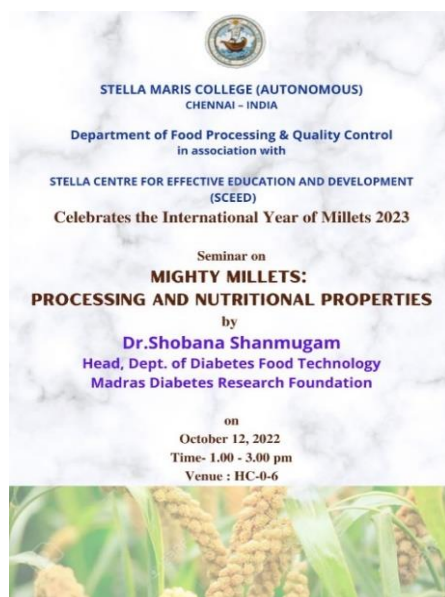


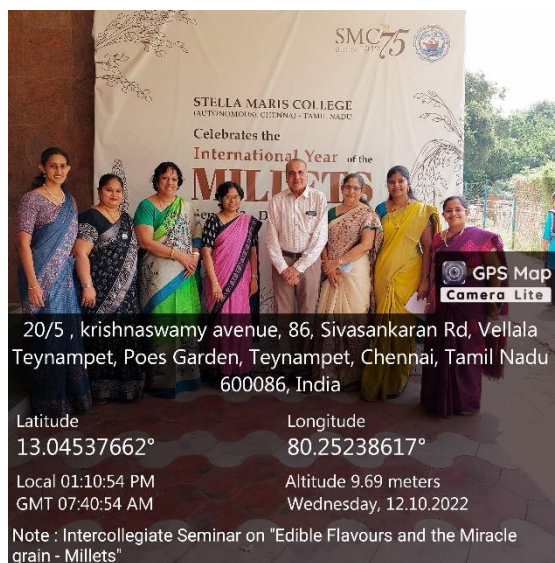
As one of the measures of reducing Plastic littering to get closer to a Zero Waste campus, the college associated with Earth Recycler Pvt Ltd., Chennai in **installing a Pet bottle Recycler** on November 23,2022 where the student will get motivational points for dropping a pet bottle in it, which can be redeemed with objects made from recycled plastic. This initiative has made a huge impact on students and the entire college community.



The **United Nations** has declared 2023 as the **International Year of Millets (IYoM)** and has urged organisations to spread awareness and conduct programmes to popularize the use of Millets. Commemorating the **IYoM**, SCEED in association with departments of Botany and Food Processing & Quality Control organised various activities to an Intercollegiate seminar by eminent personnel in the field of millets.

Dr. Shobana, senior scientist from **Madras Diabetes Research Foundation** spoke on ‘**Mighty Millets: Processing and Nutritional Properties**’. About 120 students attended the lecture on **October 12, 2022** that exposed them to the reality that Millets were good nutraceuticals and that they have functional food properties. She presented food products that were prepared with millets and highlighted their benefits.





On October 19, 2022 Mr.Senthil Kumar Babu, Founder of Iyarkai Tech Lab Pvt.Ltd addressed about 100 students on the topic ‘ **Maximising Millet Magic**’ He described the various varieties of millets that are grown in India and the uniqueness of each millet and their nutritional value. He extolled the virtues of collective efforts in reviving the use of millets and also the production of millets in small gardens. The intellectual and stimulating discussion helped the students to understand the importance of including millets in their diet.





As an initiative to make an impact on the food habits of young students, an **Exhibition** was organised in the college premises on **October 21, 2022** to popularise the use of Millets. There was a display and sale of Millet and Millet based products of different varieties to suit the lifestyle of different categories of people. Industries such as Moon Foods Pvt. Ltd., Tamilnadu Women's Collective, Iyarkai Pvt. Ltd. Aadhava Foods, Native Foods, D'Organica, Dhaan Foundation and eager students of the departments of Botany and Food Processing & Quality Control exhibited a multitude of products. Awareness posters and Charts depicting the uniqueness of millets including their cultivation in different soil conditions were displayed. A few enterprising participants also demonstrated traditional recipes that caught the attention of the students. Industries such as and. SCEED facilitated the partnership of the College with the **Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS)** through the setting up of the **Standards Club**. The Standards Club, an initiative of the BIS is a step towards amassing the power of youth towards spreading awareness on the importance of quality standards and expose students to industry level conformity assessments and basis of quality certifications for goods and services.

The Standards club of Stella Maris College was inaugurated on the 10th of August 2022 in the presence of BIS officials, faculty and students. Presently the club has **104 student members** who will be carriers of the message to the community. **Dr. Subhashree S, Assistant Professor, Department of Food Processing and Quality Control is the mentor** for the club who coordinates the activities of the club in collaboration with BIS.

Interactive Sessions, Awareness Campaign in the campus, Door to Door Campaign in the community, Installation of BIS App, Visit to BIS labs, Quiz Contests, competitions such as Writing Standards, Essay writing, Poster Presentation, Seminars, Exhibition on the Significance of BIS have been conducted. The Standard Club members also participated in the activities organised by BIS such Walkathon, Celebration of World Standards Day, and Community Outreach programmes. Officials from BIS Ms. Bhavani, Mr. Yadav, Mr. Kiran and Ms. Ratna participated in the events.



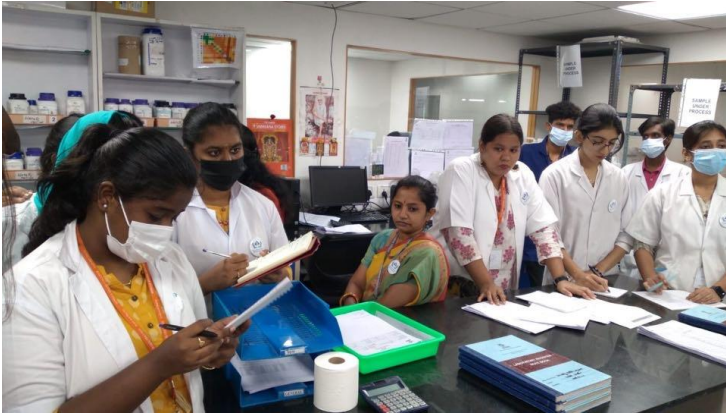
