Feedback and Action Taken Report

2018-2019

An Academic audit by external academicians was conducted and it was indicated that the learning outcomes were well defined and articulated before the start of the course. The students get Hands on Training through industrial internships and lab work. They suggested the setting up of a Food Analysis Laboratory, enhancing library resources and encouragement of student participation in intercollegiate programmes.

The Board of studies which comprised of faculty, academicians and Industry experts reviewed the syllabus and suggested that the Foundation English and Languages can be restricted to two semesters.

They opined that the Industry linkages can be increased to include all aspects of food Industry and offered to help in networking with industries and energy sector.

Action Taken:

Based on the feedback, a **Food Analysis Laboratory** was set up with a capacity to accommodate 50 students with an attached Instrumentation room. More books were acquired.

Since the University stipulation has four semesters of Foundation Courses , it was not possible to implement the suggestion to restrict the Foundation Courses to two semesters

Networking with Industry was increased and more number of MoUs were signed to facilitate internships, training sessions and recruitment



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
