The Principal has addressed the undergraduate students of the second and third year and the postgraduate students of the second year on reopening day and has given strict instructions against indulging in any form of ragging. She has also informed the hostel residents of the sanctions that they will face if they indulge in ragging. The Principal has informed the students that the student found guilty of ragging faces cancellation of admission/suspension from the College/hostel and a fine of Rs 25,000 to Rs 1,00,000 Heads of Departments and class teachers have also informed senior students on the consequences of ragging and on the need to treat every individual with respect.
