Miss Shantha Sets Up Three New Records

MADRAS, Aug. 21. WADRAS, Aug. 21. Women competitors stole the limelight in the two-day Dr. A. L. Mudaliar silver jubilee commemo-ration athletic meet which conclu-ded on the Loyola College ground last evening. They set up six new marks as against the two by men in these two days. in these two days.

Among the women competitors on view, Miss R. Shantha of Stella Maris College, stood out best creating three new marks. A Pre-University student Miss Shantha won the 200 metres clocking 28.2s., thus clipping the previous mark won the 200 metres clocking 28.2s., thus clipping the previous mark by 0.4s. In the 100 metres also she returned a new time of 13.4s., 0.1s. better than the previous re-cord that stood in the name of Rita Devasahayam, established in 1957-58. Another record that Miss Shantha shattered was the long-jump. She cleared 16 feet 4½ inches. The old record was 15 ft. 3½ inches. The old record was 15 ft. $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.

The Women's Christian College quartet led admirably by Miss Roshini George erased the old Madras University record of 58.4s. Madras University record of 58.4s. in the 4 x 100 metres relay by creating a new mark of 57.5s. Miss George also bagged the 80 metres hurdles event with consummate ease clocking 14.2s. which is 0.5s. better than the earlier record. Despite these splendid performan-ces Women's Christian College had to be content with a second place in the team championship, the first place going to Stella Ma-ris with 40 points.
