Stella Maris to launch project for deprived women

A project aimed at capacity-building or skill-training for underprivileged women was launched on November 15 by the Stella Maris Centre for Development of Resources for Inclusion and Vocational Enrichment (SMCDRIVE). 'The Livelihood Project', as it is called, looks to offer specific skill-training to women from economically weaker sections, starting with tailoring and block printing. The training will be held continuously for two months for the first batch.
