OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT

- To enhance faculty understanding of their holistic role as educators, mentors, and changemakers within and beyond the classroom.
- To familiarise staff with new institutional initiatives, policies, and tools that support a more inclusive, tech-integrated, and student-centred learning environment.
- To equip faculty with foundational counselling skills, enabling them to identify and support students facing emotional or psychological challenges.
- To raise awareness of suicidal behaviour, its predictors, and prevention strategies, promoting mental health vigilance within the college community.
- To reinforce the core values and institutional ethos of Stella Maris College, encouraging staff to embody and promote them in everyday academic practice.

DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Stella Maris College organised a Faculty Development Programme on 12 June 2025. The programme commenced with a solemn prayer led by the Department of Value Education. The spiritual invocation set a reflective and reverent tone, aligning participants with the mission of the programme and preparing hearts and minds for the day.

Session 1: Principal's Address - Dr. Sr. Stella Mary K fmm, Principal, Stella Maris College (Autonomous)

In her address, the Principal Dr. Sr. Stella Mary K fmm, warmly welcomed the faculty and emphasised the sacred responsibility of educators as co-creators in the academic and moral development of students. She highlighted four core perceptions for the year: teaching as a sacred space and vocation; educating with both knowledge and heart; leading by personal example; and growing together as a faculty community. Her message encouraged faculty members to embrace their roles not only as instructors but also as mentors and guides, making small yet consistent changes that can bring about lasting transformation in the lives of students and in the culture of the institution.

An overview of new developments and policies was presented during the programme, highlighting the institution's continued efforts to enhance the academic and support systems in place for students. Key initiatives included the introduction of the Co-curricular Transcript, the



AI Policy and Honour Code, the revamped Student Induction Programme, Library Modernisation efforts, the establishment of a Wellness Centre, and the creation of a Compendium of Policies and Guidelines.

Session 2: Basics of Counselling for Teachers – Rev. Fr. Raja, Naturopath & Counsellor

Dr. Fr. Raja spoke about the basics of counselling for teachers in a clear and relatable manner. He explained how important it is for faculty members to listen to students with empathy, offer support without judgement, and be alert to early signs of stress or emotional difficulty. He emphasised that teachers often serve not just as educators, but also as trusted adults whom students turn to in times of need. To make the session more engaging and practical, he invited two faculty members to participate in a live demonstration. One acted as the counsellor and the other as the counsellee, giving everyone a simple yet effective example of how a basic counselling conversation could take place. This helped faculty understand how they can offer meaningful support, even in small ways, during their daily interactions with students.

Session 3: Understanding Suicidal Behaviour – Prediction and Prevention - Dr. (Prof.) R. Sathianathan – Senior Consultant Psychiatrist, Chennai, Former Director of Mental Health, Government of Tamil Nadu

In this important and thought-provoking session, Dr. (Prof.) R. Sathianathan, a senior consultant psychiatrist, shared his deep expertise on the topic of mental health, with a special focus on understanding suicidal behaviour. He spoke about the various risk factors and warning signs that teachers should be aware of, such as sudden changes in behaviour, withdrawal from peers, or expressions of hopelessness. He stressed that early recognition of these signs can make a significant difference in preventing a crisis. Dr. Sathianathan also provided practical strategies that faculty members can use to support students who may be at risk. These included creating an open and non-judgmental space for students to talk, encouraging help-seeking behaviour, and referring students to trained professionals when needed. Additionally, he spoke about the role of institutions in building a strong support system through awareness programmes, mental health policies, and collaboration with counsellors and mental health experts. The session served as a valuable reminder that faculty members can play a key role in creating a safe, caring, and responsive environment that promotes student well-being and prevents tragedies.



Session 4: *Institutional Ethos* - Dr. Sr. Flavia Mariapragasam fmm, Department of Value Education, Stella Maris College (Autonomous) and moderated by Dr. Margaret Thomas, Vice-Principal - Shift I, Stella Maris College (Autonomous)

This interactive session focused on revisiting and reflecting on the foundational values that form the ethos of Stella Maris College. The session began with Dr. Sr. Flavia Mariapragasam sharing her insights on the meaning and significance of the College's ethos, drawing attention to how these values are lived out in daily actions and institutional culture. Key values such as faith, compassion, integrity, service, academic freedom, excellence, inclusivity, and the empowerment of women were highlighted as the guiding principles of the institution. Following her presentation, faculty members were divided into 12 teams, each guided by a facilitator. Each team was assigned one of the core ethos themes: Curiosity, Excellence, Initiative, Integrity, Discipline, Compassion, Tradition, Credibility, and Freedom. Within their groups, faculty engaged in meaningful discussions around two key questions: Which ethos of SMC resonates most deeply with you? You may also share a personal value that aligns with or complements these core beliefs, and How do you think you can contribute to strengthening this shared belief and passing it on to the student community? All faculty participated in the right spirit, actively sharing their reflections, ideas, and suggestions during the session.

OUTCOMES OF THE EVENT

By the end of the programme, the new faculty members were able to

- Renew their commitment to the mission, vision, and values of Stella Maris College.
- Develop greater sensitivity and preparedness in recognising and responding to student mental health needs.
- Strengthen their skills in offering initial counselling support and guiding students to appropriate professional help.
- Improve the sense of community and collaboration among colleagues, promoting a culture of mutual support and collective growth.
