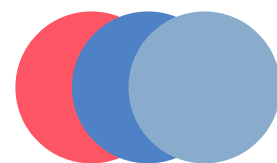
A Webinar was organised on '**Yoga for Wellbeing**' for the cadets on 21 June 2021 on the occasion of **International Yoga Day 2021**.

The **Inter-platoon competition** for the second year cadets was held on the 27 and 28 of August 2021.



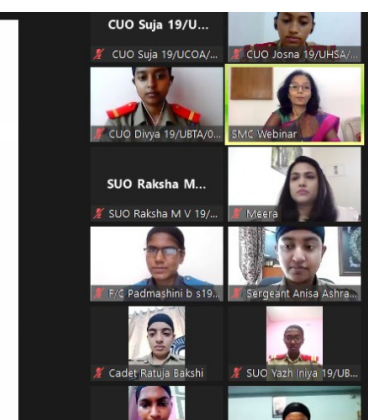

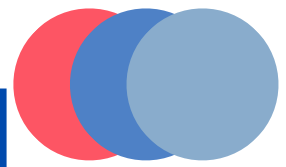
The Naval Cadets attended the **CATC cum Boat Pulling Camp** at SRM Kattankulathur during from 27 November to 06 December 2021.

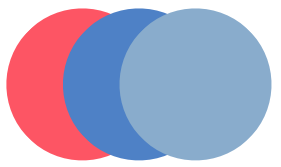

In November 2021, 19 first year, 9 second year and 12 third year Naval Cadets participated in the **Tree Plantation Drive**.



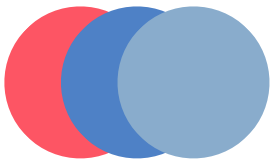
