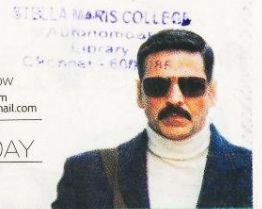

Mongolian warrior and ruler, Genghis Khan, one of the most famous conquerors of history, died on this day in 1227
