

The first IQAC advisory committee meeting for the academic year 2022–2023 began at 10:30 a.m. on November 25, 2022 at the Jayshree Venkatraman Digital Learning and Research Centre (JVDLRC), SS Block. Dr. Lakshmi Priya Daniel, IQAC Coordinator, welcomed the gathering and requested Ms. Devadharshini Anbudurai, Students' Union General Secretary for 2022–2023, to render the prayer. Dr. Daniel invited Dr. Sr. Rosy Joseph fmm, Principal and Chairperson to start the proceedings, who shared regarding many activities, especially the work in progress on autonomy extension report preparation and

various audits that had been completed till date, including a social audit, an accessibility audit, and a green and energy audit. She also mentioned that the College website had recently been updated to include the auditory mode to make it user friendly for the visually impaired.

Dr. Daniel presented a PowerPoint listing out the activities from the beginning of the new academic year in July 2022 and also welcomed the three new external members who were joining the IQAC Advisory Committee: Mr. Arul Dev, Founder CEO, People First Consultants, as the nominee from local society; Dr. Lakshmi Vaideeswaran, Vice President – Analytics Consulting, Tiger Analytics, as the nominee from employers/industrialists/stakeholders; and Ms. Mathavi Thangaraj, Placement Coordinator, Stella Maris College, as the alumna reperesentative. All the members were requested to introduce themselves briefly, and then the floor was opened for discussion. Dr. Vaideeswaran, while commending the committed work the college is rendering, spoke of the need for being more agile in collecting feedback from stakeholders in order to create a better impact. Dr. Daniel explained that there were certain mechanisms already in place for feedback regarding the curriculum, teacher evaluation, and from alumni. She added that the college has a social media presence allowing for live feedback platforms, which was endorsed by Dr. Vaideeswaran, who suggested the need to communicate clearly and widely that "we are a listening institute and we do care for everyone." Mr. Dev expressed the same need for greater and better visibility for the college, especially in terms of recruitment, which was seconded by Dr. Vaideeswaran. Both of them stressed the need for better marketing in order to showcase the enormous work potential of the college and keep it in the topmost tier of academia. Ms. Mathavi Thangaraj added that recruiting corporations often ask for technology-capable graduates and suggested that it could be built into every programme's curriculum in accordance with the feedback collected from employers.

Dr. Daniel called upon the student representatives to render their suggestions, and in the meantime, Dr. Leema Francis pointed out that while acknowledging industry requirements and demands, the college had been doing its best to ensure better employability through professional programmes and integrating skill-based courses to showcase students' talents. Mr. Dev urged the members to reflect on realising the need for enhancing the all-round performance of our students in the real world by grooming them to play at a different level from the time of admission through the three years with greater energy and enthusiasm. He stressed the fact that this fresh energy must emanate from and be centred within the college in order to blend tradition and modernity grounded in sound values. Dr. Vaideeswaran went on to say that the development of the technical designs for the various programmes in the college were up to par but emphasised the need for better application methods and creative connections to be facilitated in order to bring projects and internship opportunities and thus prepare students for the industry. Dr. Renuka Rajaratnam verbalised that institutions pick up the cues from the West to meet the challenges of balancing students' academic requirements with industry readiness, facilitating research innovation while keeping in mind market trends and employability. While looking to the west, Dr. Vaideeswaran added that we can use the fresh energy brought in by PG and PhD students' research to get the quality jump and augment meaningful industry associations through alumnae.

Dr. Bernadine Joseph articulated the need to review the approach to curriculum design to become more innovative and creative, in order to ensure that the teaching enables a student to learn and think. Dr. Vaideeswaran shared her experience of taking a course on critical thinking, which was disruptive and immensely beneficial in helping her think differently. Mr. Dev agreed on the need to facilitate learning for students by not just thrusting inputs upon them but also drawing something out of them. He did, however, caution against the arbitrary use of critical thinking, which has to be balanced out by the use of more holistic methods in order to bring in innovative development. Ms. Latha K stated that the varied levels of students

have to be addressed, and Dr. Sr. Rosy Joseph added that the needs of the slow learners had to be factored in order for them to be taken along with the rest of the learners. Mr. Dev identified this as the 'plus' of the institution, which catered to diverse needs, and how this will further help to bring out the 'gifts' that lie within each and every student.

This was the need of the hour, he said: to identify and develop the natural gifts latent in the students and not focus only on employability in the garb of training for placements. A lively discussion ensued on the possibilities of enhancing learning through formal and informal methods and the challenges of being within the system while bridging the gap for students with diverse needs.

Dr. Sasitha next spoke about the continued demand for enrolment into Stella Maris College and asked about employers' requirements specifically from our graduates so that it can be included programme-wise into the curriculum. To this, Mr. Dev made the observation that the students are surprisingly reticent and suggested that the culture has to evolve to encourage assertiveness and coming forward, which was reiterated by Dr. Rajaratnam, who said that questioning and self-learning should be lauded.

The Students' Union member, Ms. Sangeerthana Maria, voiced that the third component assignments could be better used to bring out the creativity of students. She also shared experiences from a visit to the 'Innovation Park' where venture capitalists interact with students, and suggested the initiation of a similar space for the students to think and ideate. Ms. Devadharshini brought up the issue of the Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) not being open for Commerce Shift 1 students, to which the response was that since it was an initiative of Commerce Shift 2, it was offered to them in the evening shift. It was also brought forward by members that the newly started "Incubation and Innovation Center" in the SS Block was to be open to all students and would be fully operational in the near future to cater to the needs expressed. Both Dr. Vaideeswaran and Mr. Dev looped back the suggestions by the students for achieving a fine balance between curriculum design and innovation, employability, and quality development, all while retaining the core values that the college has as its bedrock.

Dr. Sr. Rosy Joseph echoed the sentiments of the IQAC Coordinator, who spoke of the manner in which the institution seeks out and rises to every challenge but also pointed out the lacunae in students' willingness to respond. The external members, in response, assured with alacrity their support to achieve better engagement and feedback from all stakeholders, which was welcomed by the entire fraternity.

Dr. Daniel concluded the meeting by thanking everyone and stating that the next one will be held at the start of the new year in 2023.
