Scope of Agreement:

I. Student Development Program

This agreement shall be applicable to the exchange of all students between Stella Maris and IESEG. The parties mutually agree upon which academic fields or disciplines are covered under the terms of this agreement. Each party reserves the right to exclude students from restricted enrollment programs.

Definitions: As used herein, the terms "Host University" and "Home University" shall have the following meanings:
a) Host University: the university accepting the exchanged students.
b) Home University: the university providing the exchanged students.

VII. Term of Agreement and Modification

The terms of this Agreement may be changed or modified only by written amendment signed by both parties.

This Agreement shall be effective as of the date of the last signature and continue in full force and effect until terminated by the parties hereto. Official review and evaluation of this Agreement and of the program will take place three (3) years after the initial implementation of this Agreement.

1. Background

- 1.1. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) made between the Stella Maris College (SMC) and ACCA provides for the establishment of a mutual co-operation between these two institutions.
- 1.2. Recognising the value of promoting mutual co-operation for the advancement of their respective members and the accountancy and tax professions, Stella Maris College (SMC) and ACCA agree to the following terms as set out below.

2. Purpose

- 2.1. The purpose of this MoU is to set out the understanding between the Parties without any intention to create legal relations, rather in the spirit of mutual cooperation. Any collaborative ventures that may bind the Parties are subject to separate contractual arrangements. The purpose of this MoU is to explore opportunities for collaboration to their mutual benefit, to set out the respective roles and responsibilities of the Parties in working cooperatively to further each other's and their mutual interests.
- 2.2. No funding will be required from either Party except as mutually agreed from time to time. The Parties agree that all financial arrangements will be negotiated for each specific case prior to commencement of the activity and will depend on the availability of funds.

3. Duration and Termination

- 3.1. This MOU will be deemed to have come into force and effect on the Commencement Date and will continue for a period of three (3) years from that date. The parties agree to review this MOU annually. This MOU may be terminated at any time during its term by either ACCA or Stella Maris College (SMC) upon three (3) months' prior written notice to the other.

11. Good Faith

- 11.1. In entering into this MOU, the parties recognise that it is impractical to make provisions for every contingency that may arise during the course of the MOU.
- 11.2. Accordingly, the parties declare it to be their intention that this MOU shall operate between them in accordance with the principles of good faith, with fairness and without detriment to the interests of anyone and if any dispute arises, the parties shall use commercially reasonable endeavours to agree upon such action as may be necessary and equitable to remove or resolve the cause or causes of the same.

2. Areas of cooperation

Cooperation between the Parties will include (not limited to) the following areas:

2.1. Educational and cultural activities

- 2.1.1. organization of academic mobility programs for undergraduate students, post-graduate students and higher-education teaching personnel;
- 2.1.2. exchange of personnel for teaching and lecturing;
- 2.1.3. exchange of experience in the organization and methods of teaching, educational technologies, exchange of teaching materials;

6. Final Provisions

- 6.1. The realization of specific joint projects is implemented by the Parties on the basis of independent contracts.
- 6.2. Memorandum may be amended or supplemented by mutual Memorandum of the Parties. Additions and changes are to be made in writing with a duplicate in the form of a supplementary appendix to this Memorandum and should be signed by the Parties.
- 6.3. Each Party shall have the right to terminate this Memorandum by written notice to the other Party. In this case the Memorandum is terminated after one month of receipt by the other Party of such notice.

7. Responsibilities of the Parties

- 7.1. Parties are responsible for disclosure of information made known to the Parties in the process of joint activity and recognized by them confidential in written form by the procedure established by current legislation of the Russian Federation and Latvia.

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into at Chennai on this 23rd day of September in the Year 2019.

BETWEEN:

ISDC Projects India Pvt. Ltd, trading as ISDC - International Skill Development Corporation and having its Regional Office at Lakshmi Narayan Complex, Palace Road, Vasanth Nagar, Bengaluru, and Karnataka - 560052 represented by its Regional Manager, Mr. Calvin Fredy Paul, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY

Both parties as above have expressed a desire of entering into a Memorandum of Understanding to meet their respective objectives, which are set out herein below.

WHEREAS

- a. - Each party undertakes to the other that it will not disclose or make use of, for its own benefit, any of the Confidential Information of that other party.
17. All disputes and differences of any kind whatever arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be referred to the arbitration, and the final decision of an arbitrator jointly appointed by both the parties to be agreed upon and appointed by both the parties, or in case of disagreement as to the appointment of a single arbitrator, two arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party and if there are two arbitrators, they shall before taking upon themselves the burden of reference appoint a third arbitrator who shall act as Presiding Arbitrator. This submission to the arbitrators shall be deemed to be a submission to arbitration within the meaning of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, or any statutory modification thereof. The award of the arbitrator or arbitrators as the case may be, shall be final and binding on the parties.
 18. This MoU does not bear any legal action status. However, in case of any disputes not settled due to arbitration it will be subject to the courts of Bangalore Jurisdiction.

SECOND:

To work towards capacity-building of the university community, namely, professors and researchers, in order to reinforce their work and, thereby, the institution's intellectual, Christian, economic, social, political and human impact.

THIRD:

To implement a 3-year action-research project entitled "*Continuing Education for Disadvantaged Adolescents in South-Asia*", bringing together a total of 5 institutions within the region along with experts from other geographical areas.

This international project falls under the overall direction and coordination of IFCU, which is due to provide scientific, administrative, technical and financial orientation for its effective implementation.

FORTH:

To set up a work calendar for each year stating the tasks to be accomplished, the meetings taking place, the training sessions addressed to participating teams and the eventual deliverables to be produced within the concerned timeframe.

The calendar for the year 2017 is hereby attached as **Annex 1**.

A supplementary annex will be attached at the beginning of each year during which the current cooperation is underway.

FIFTH:

To provide the incumbent team with financial aid that will be allocated to the personnel involved in the project (salary allowance), namely, the project director officially appointed within the institution and the other team members in accordance with the extent of their involvement, as well as any other project tasks or services incurring costs.

Extra allowances may be allocated to individuals or institutions performing specific tasks expressly requested by IFCU.

A supplementary Annex will be attached stating the exact amount of the grant allocated.

To make the collaboration as defined herein effective as of February 27th, 2017.

Memorandum of Understanding
For International Education Cooperation

Alamo Community College District, a political subdivision of the state of Texas, (herein after referred to as "Alamo Colleges") and Stella Maris College (Autonomous), located in Chennai, India (collectively referred to herein as "the Parties"), wishing to develop friendly and cooperative relations in the fields of education and research, have concluded the present Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

WHEREAS, Alamo Colleges and Stella Maris College (Autonomous) desire to develop the enrichment of their teaching and research programs; and

WHEREAS, Alamo Colleges and Stella Maris College (Autonomous) desire to strengthen and expand the mutual contacts between the two institutions; and

WHEREAS, Alamo Colleges and Stella Maris College (Autonomous) desire to provide for an exchange of faculty and students as well as other collaboration between the two institutions on the terms and conditions included in this memorandum.

Therefore, it is mutually agreed as follows:

Terms of Agreement

- 1.1 Themes of joint activities and the conditions for utilizing the results achieved and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be developed mutually for each specific case through a Cooperative/Reciprocal Agreement (herein after referred to as "Implementing Agreement"). Any commitment of resources, financial or otherwise, must be made in specific agreements to be entered into for this purpose at a subsequent date.
- 1.2 Each exchange under the terms of this Agreement will be initiated by the respective colleges of Alamo Colleges and Stella Maris College (Autonomous). The details of each exchange shall be agreed upon in writing in an Implementing Agreement by the designated liaison officials of each institution.
- 1.3 Realization of separate concrete projects within the frames of the MOU will be stipulated in separate Implementing Agreements.
- 1.4 This MOU will become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the institutions and, if applicable, approval by appropriate authorities in their respective countries.
- 1.5 The MOU will be in force for five years and may be renewed upon written agreement of the parties for subsequent terms. Either party wishing to make changes or terminate the MOU shall notify the other partner in writing of such intentions no later than six months before the suggested changes should go into effect.
- 1.6 Each party reserves the right to unilaterally terminate the MOU should the other partner fail to fulfill its responsibilities as stated herein after three months prior notice to the other side.

Memorandum of Understanding

between

Stella Maris College

and

Providence University

Stella Maris College and Providence University, wishing to establish relations between the two institutions, agree to cooperate with each other as follows:

Scope of the Cooperation

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either institution as thought desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides think will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

- a. Exchange of students and/or interns
- b. Exchange of faculty and/or staff
- c. Joint research activities and publications
- d. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
- e. Exchange of academic materials and other information
- f. Special short-term academic programs

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendixes to this Memorandum of Understanding. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities and programs agreed upon.

Renewal, Termination and Amendment

This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for an indefinite time from the date of the final signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving 12 months notice to the other party in writing, unless an earlier termination date is mutually agreed upon. The Memorandum of Understanding may be amended


or extended between two parties in writing as an addendum to this agreement.
