- Leading Together is a collaboration between undergraduate students at the Faculty of Arts at the University of Melbourne and undergraduate students at four institutions across India comprising Tetso College in Nagaland, Stella Maris College in Chennai (affiliated with the University of Madras), Savitribai Phule Pune University in Pune and the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Guwahati Campus and Tuljapur Campus. This is a place for students in India and Australia to connect with each other and discuss the role of young women and leadership across health, technology, education and sustainability
- The Leading Together Dialogue with the University of Melbourne continued in November 2021 with the students attending the programme online with partnering institutions.

Having trained from Madras Medical College, Dr. Gomathi went on to pursue transplant training from the USA and Japan. She has over 20 years of experience in Transplant surgery, with a special focus on transplantation for children. She is a marathon runner and believes in the power of fitness and health as one of the key aspects in determining a woman's mental strength and confidence.
