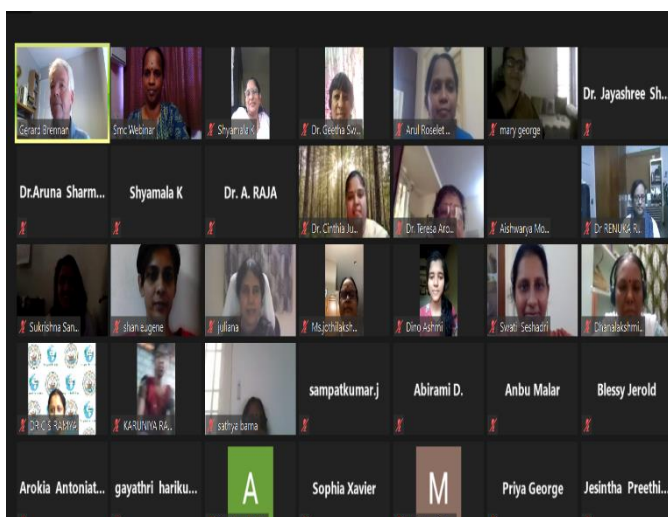

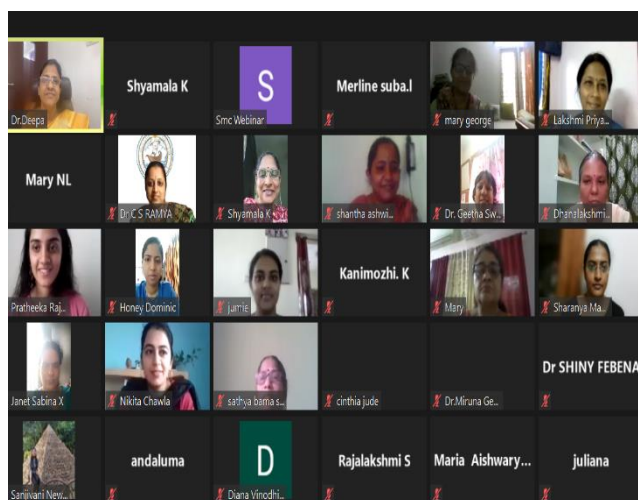

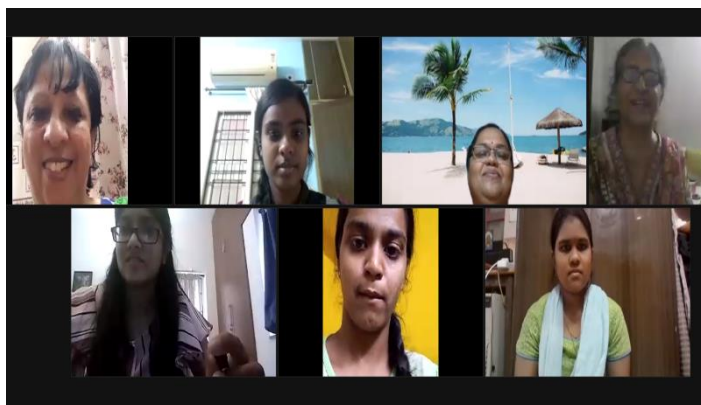

Echoing the ideals of St. Francis, SCEED took up programs to initiate measures for a Zero Waste Campus. Webinars were organised on “Biogas- Waste to Energy”, Mr. Kern Agrawal, Director, Carbon Loops Pvt. Ltd. showcased the advancements made in society through production of Biogas. He spoke on measures to mitigate the issue of waste pollution on the environment and gave suggestions on the conversion of waste to biogas. A demonstration on the different steps involved in setting up a biogas plant was conducted.

The challenge of the looming problem of electronic waste and mitigation measures were addressed by “World Scrap Recycling Solutions Pvt. Ltd” in the webinar on “Erase E Waste”. The resource persons described the ill effects of dumping electronic wastes in landfills and provided solutions to minimise and recycle the E waste.

To instil the notion of No Waste, an **offline workshop** was conducted titled “Zero Waste - A Step Forward - WoW - Wealth Out of Waste” The professional team headed by Ms.Arulpriya, CEO of Namma Bhoomi demonstrated the conversion of different types of wastes into useful products. She also showcased alternatives for commonly used plastic products such as cutlery, toothbrushes, straws and also the reuse of various wastes. The students were also shown the techniques of making Home disinfectants from the kitchen wastes. Upscaling was perceived by the students and faculty.










Taking into cognizance the significance and the bearing of **Outcome Based Education** in educational Institutes, SCEED facilitated Faculty Development Programmes for all the faculty through workshops on Outcomes Based Education, Learning Outcome Based Curriculum Framework and Course Mapping.

The session on LOCF was conducted for all the faculty which was followed by workshops in groups to provide a hands on training in planning the curriculum based on the framework of OBE. The faculty in four different groups were familiarized with the nuances of designing the curriculum to include the POs, PSOs, COs. The resource persons from Loyola College also elaborated on Course Mapping and Graduate Attainment Measurements.

Dr.M.C.John Milton, Head, Dept. of Advanced Zoology & Biotechnology and Dr. Joel Gnanadoss, Head, Dept. of Plant Biology & Biotechnology, Loyola College conducted Workshop on **“Learning Outcomes Based Curriculum Framework”** for the faculty of Shift I and Shift II. The structure and modalities of the various levels of LOCF was discussed in detail. The significance of PO, PSO, CO and their mapping was emphasised and outlined the assessment pattern based on Bloom’s Taxonomy.

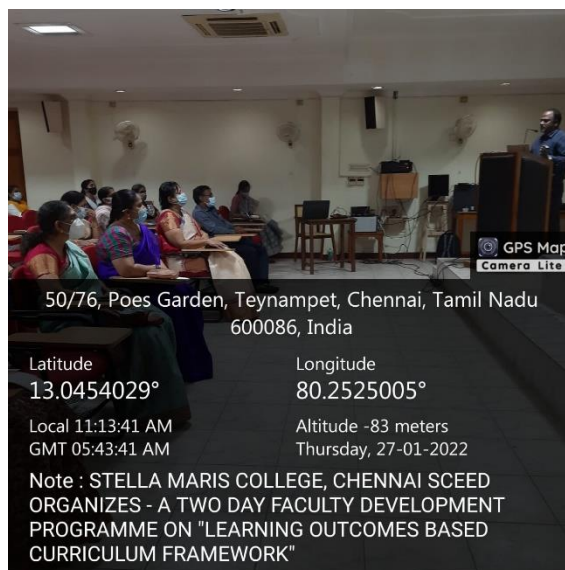
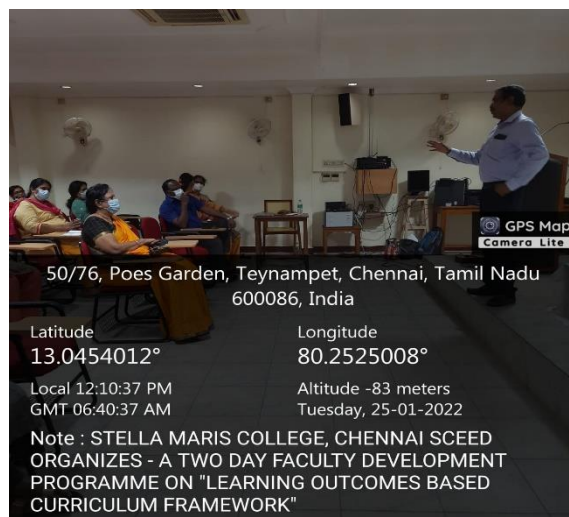

The Science faculty were trained in two groups through two days sessions on “**Workshop on Course Mapping**”. Dr.John Milton, Dr.Joel and Dr.Bharathi from the School of Science, Loyola College stressed on the need for OBE and explained the processes and various aspects of the implementation of OBE. The faculty worked in disciplinewise groups to formulate POs, PSOs and COs. Departmentwise presentations were made and the course mapping and

attainment was elucidated by the resource persons. The outcome of the sessions were that the faculty have acquired skills to incorporate OBE elements during curriculum framing.

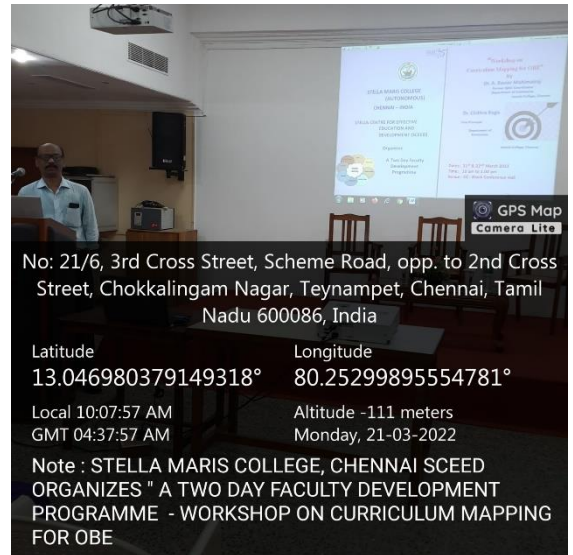

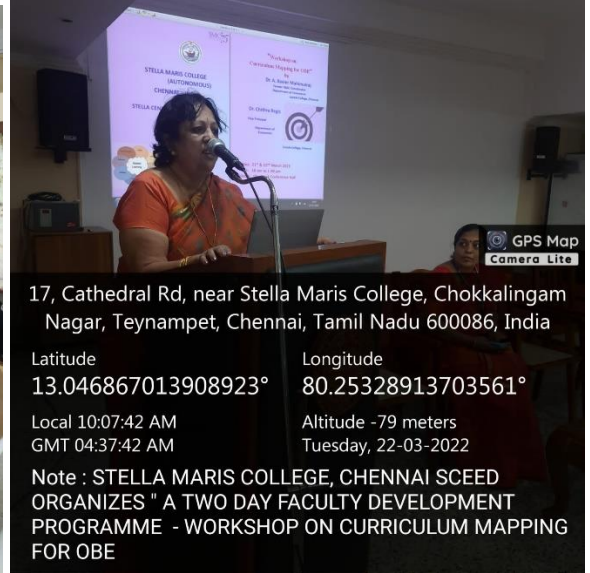

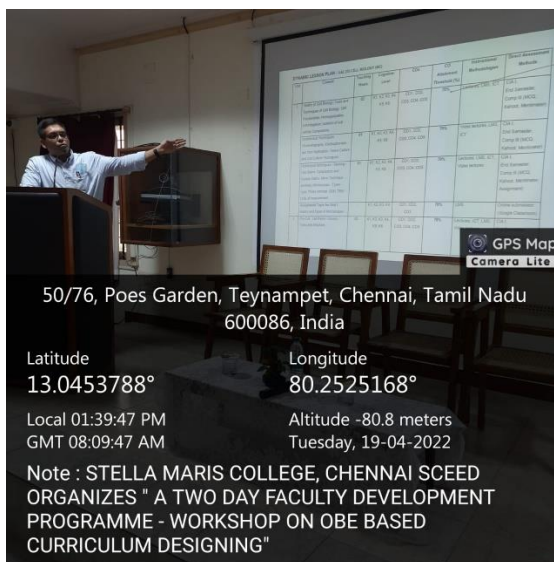
