- **A.** SMCNC helps the college to reach out to chambers of commerce, corporate, service, government and non-governmental organizations and thus facilitates **networking** of the college with various organizations:
 - In this context, Dr. K. Sundari was an invited speaker to the Andhra Chamber of Commerce to present a researched paper through an audio-visual presentation on "Tradition and Mythology as Management Sutras for Today" on <u>June 6,2014</u> at the KCP Ltd., Egmore, Chennai.



2. SMCNC networked with a large number of NGO's in Chennai and Pardada Pardadi Educational Foundation (P.P.E.F) in Anupshahr Village in U.P. The Founder and Chairman of P.P.E.F, Mr. Sam Virender Singh, formerly on the board of DuPont in U.S.A, visited our college on Jan 23, 2015 .Mr. Singh had just organized a girl's marathon for the first time in his village on August 14, 2014. Sr. Principal and Dr. K. Sundari had visited Anupshahr earlier.





3. SMC had been selected as the **only partner in Tamil Nadu** to run the 9 month certificate program in Corporate Social Responsibility (ICP-CSR) with an MoU being signed between SMC AND IICA.

6. In this **education-government partnership**, SMC has the first batch of ICP-CSR students, from **13th October 2014**, enrolled in the 18 weeks of online classes, 4 weeks of contact classes, 3 weeks of corporate attachment and 9 weeks of N.G.O attachment.

- The first batch of ICP-CSR have had a welcome prayer meeting, intensive Library orientation and a Christmas celebration along with studying and taking 3 exams and one attachment. Ms. Gayathri Rao, Program Officer, N.F.C.S.R visited the college on 20th & 21st November, 2014.
- 8. SMCNC was the first to organize a **Management Development Program** (M.D.P) on "Career Opportunities in Corporate Social Responsibility on **February 24th**, **2015 at**

L & T's Construction Skill Training Institute (C.S.T.I) in Ennathur village, Kanchipuram.

• This program was a good mix of **field observation** along with **expert presentations** by L & T and I.I.C.A



• The M.D.P was an education-corporate-government joint enterprise to reach out to 141 students & 12 faculty and staff, who travelled in 3 buses from SMC to Kanchipuram. (Photo 9)
