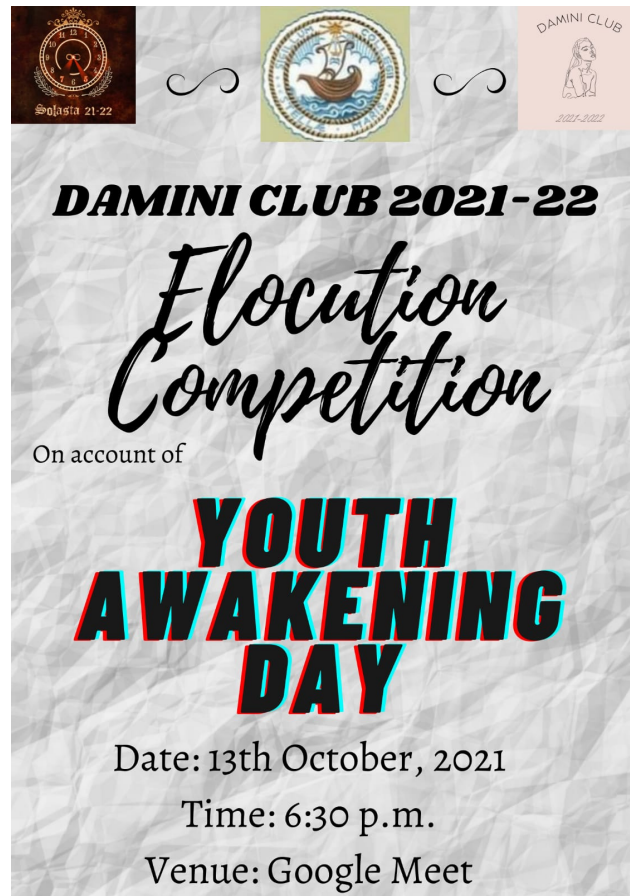


SPEECH COMPETITION
